What is ANGEL FOOD MINISTRIES and how does it work?

Angel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing grocery relief to communities throughout the United States. This ministries program began in 1994. For \$30, participants receive food worth approximately \$60. Once a month, you (or someone you would like to help), can order wonderful boxes of frozen meats, fresh or frozen fruits and vegetables, and staple items. This is top quality food that you would find in the best grocery stores. It is not "day-old" or "outdated" items. The variety of items is designed to assist in feeding a family of four for about one week, or a single citizen for almost a month. The menu changes every month, with the average box weighing 21 pounds. You are under no obligation to order every month. Angel Food is not a program based on need or income. There are no applications, no qualifications, no membership fees and no limits. All orders must be paid for in advance by either cash, checks or EBT Food Stamps.
