EVSC students and parents/guardians,

The mandatory return of the netbooks that were assigned to high school students this school year will take place the week of May 24-27. Netbooks will be checked in, assessed for damage by our vendor and then sent out for software refresh and hardware restoration. Next school year, the netbooks will be reassigned to the same student if he/she returns to that school. Students who enroll in a different EVSC school next year will be assigned a netbook at that school.

Each student is responsible for returning the netbook, the battery, and the two-piece power cord/power adapter which is used to charge the netbook battery. They may keep the blue cover given out to protect the netbooks. Students should back up all files saved on the hard drive and the H: drive to an external location (on a flash drive, for example) as those files will be deleted during the refresh process.

The replacement fees for any missing items and the repair charges for any assessed damages will be billed to the parent. If a netbook is not returned by the end of school on May 27th, the parent will be assessed the replacement cost of the netbook, \$460.
