### ED CENTER PROGRAM

The ED Center (Extended Day Care) Program is available for children who need care before and/or after school. Children may attend before school from 6:30 a.m. until school starts and from the end of the school day until 6:00 p.m. A fee will be charged to parents who are late picking up their children.

Any child enrolled in elementary school, K-5 is eligible to attend on a first-come, first-served basis. Fees must be paid by the first day of the week of attendance. If children are in attendance only part of the week, full payment is expected for the entire week.

Parents may choose to have their children attend on a daily, rather than a weekly basis. The fee on a daily basis is \$6.50 per day for the morning program and \$11.50 for the afternoon program. Parents are responsible for all transportation.

Children in the morning program will be able to purchase breakfast at the school cafeteria. Snacks will be provided for the afternoon program.

Opportunities will be provided for study and enrichment. The ED Centers have space for students to do homework, read for pleasure, and participate in recreational activities.

### SCHOOL CLOSING DELAYED OPENING / EARLY DISMISSAL

The ED Centers are open only when schools are open. If schools are closed because of weather or other emergency, the ED Center will be closed and no charge will be made for that day. If a school makeup day is scheduled, the ED Center will be open and a charge will be added for the makeup day. If there is a delayed opening or early dismissal due to weather or other emergency, the following procedures will be followed:

- \* Ed Centers will be open at 6:30 a.m. even if a delayed opening of school is announced. There will be extra charges for day care if school begins after the normal start time of 8:05 a.m. The ED Center coordinator will have information on extra charges.
- \* If school is cancelled after a delayed opening, parents should pick up their children as soon as possible. Early pick-up will avoid additional day care charges.
- \* If an early dismissal occurs before 12:00 noon, the ED Center afternoon session will be cancelled.
- \* If early dismissal occurs after 12:00 noon, the Ed Center will be open until 6:00 p.m. There will be extra charges for daycare for the time between early dismissal and the regular dismissal time of 2:16 p.m. In case of a weather emergency, parents are encouraged to pick up their children as soon as possible.
