FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING ENROLLMENT

Can I enroll at Central if I don't live in this school district??

Students must attend the high school in the district in which they reside.

What do I need to have with me when I enroll my child??

1. If you are transferring from another EVSC school all you will need to provide is proof of residence.
2. If you are new to the EVSC you must provide the proof of residence along with the following:
 - a) a birth certificate (the certificate from the health dept/not the pretty one the hospital gives you with the foot prints on it).
 - b) immunization records for your child
 - c) the name and telephone number of your child's former school

If I am not the student's legal guardian, can I enroll them in school?

In order to enroll a child in school, you must be the child's custodial parent or legal guardian. You may be required to provide a copy of the court order that establishes you as the child's custodial parent or legal guardian. If the child is living in your home but you are not their custodial parent or legal guardian, you must obtain a duties and liabilities form from Student Services, Room 101 of the EVSC Admin. Bldg. 435-8463.

What is "proof of residence?"

Proof of Residence is an item that proves you live at the address you claim to live. We will accept a copy of your utility bills, rent or mortgage statements, or a piece of mail sent to you at your address by a government entity. We will not generally accept a driver's license, checkbook or hand written rent receipt as proof of residence. If you are living at the address you claim to be living but are unable to provide proof of residence, you will need to meet with one of our assistant principals who will explain what options you may have.

What is an Adjustment Transfer? An Adjustment Transfer is a transfer from one EVSC school to another that is approved by both school principals and Student Services. Adjustment Transfers are granted based on the reason/need for the transfer and you are not always permitted to pick the school you will transfer to. You must apply for an Adjustment Transfer at your home school. The principal there will meet with you and decide if an application for Adjustment Transfer is warranted for your circumstances.

My child is Special Education. Is there anything else I need to know about enrollment?

Yes. If a student is Special Education, the school must have a copy of the student's I.E.P. to place that student in Special Education classes. We will have the parent and student meet with our Special Education Dept. Head during the enrollment process in order to ensure all the student's needs are being met.

My child was expelled from their last school. Can I enroll him/her?

If your child was expelled from school, you can only re-enroll that child if there has been one of the following events:

1. a case conference for special education students placing the student at Central High School
2. a re-entry hearing for non special education students placing the student at Central High School
3. you have received a letter from the EVSC stating that you may enroll your student back in school.

Can I obtain assistance for the cost of my child's books and/or lunches? You can apply for our free and reduced book and lunch program. Assistance is based on income. You need to see Mrs. Klausmeier, in the Assistant Principal's office for an application.

My child was home schooled before enrolling at Central. What do I need to provide in order for him/her to receive the credits they earned by home school instruction?

A copy of the students grades and the curriculum covered in home school instruction will need to be provided to the building principal for review. Any credits granted based on home school instruction are at the discretion of the EVSC. For more information contact the school assistant principal's office.
