STUDENTS: The EVSC rules allow students to regain citizenship for violations of attendance rules only December 7th is the deadline for turning in documentation of volunteer services of 20 hours. These hours must be done after you lost the citizenship rating. You must contact Mrs. Settle to discuss eligibility and the procedures to follow with the 20 hours of voluntary services before you do the work. Voluntary hours must be approved by Mrs. Settle and your guardian. December 7th is the last day to turn in the documentation of the volunteer hours performed.

REMINDER to all students of all the upcoming enrollment meetings: Nov. 23rd-3rd period Current Sophomores in the auditorium, Nov. 25th-3rd period Current Freshmen in the auditorium. Students will be asked to **go to homeroom for attendance** and leave everything there except the sign-up sheets and a pencil. TURNABOUT GUESTS: If you are planning to bring a guest to the Turnabout Dance, you will need to pick-up a Dance Guest Request Form from the Counselor's Office. This

form needs to be completed and returned to the school before tickets can be purchased during the week of Nov. 3-Dec. 4. A guest MUST be at least a freshman in high school, but not over the age of 20. If the guest is not a student of this school, the individual must bring a state-issued photo ID. All non-school students must abide by all school rules while at the dance. Please do not wait until the week of Nov. 30-Dec. 4 to pick up one of these forms. The form needs to be signed by an administrator from the guest's high school. (It takes time to complete and return) Completed forms should be returned to the Attendance Office.
