English Notes

English 9H is the gifted and talented accelerated course offering for any Core 40 diplomas. Eligibility is predetermined. Other enrollment requests will be considered based upon teacher input, grades, work ethic, etc.

Social Studies Notes

U. S. History H is an accelerated class designed for high level students who have excellent reading/writing skills and a great passion for History. This is not exclusively for the gifted and talented students.

Technology Notes

The prerequisite for Intro to Engineering Design (PLTW) is completion of at least PreAlgebra with a grade of A or B.

Math Prerequisites

PreAlgebra (every day math) students should have had PreAlgebra or Algebra but may be having difficulty in the course. This course will meet every day and cover all of the basic Algebra skills. Students who did not pass ISTEP must enroll in both of these courses.

Algebra I (1 year Algebra) students should have completed both PreAlgebra and Algebra **with a grade of 'B' or better.**

Algebra II H students should have completed PreAlgebra and Algebra **with a grade of 'A' and must have passed the Math End of Course Assessment (ECA) for Algebra I (required for graduation).**

World Languages Notes

Only students who have completed 2 full years of Spanish or German **with a grade of 'B' or better** in middle school can receive 1 yr of high school credit and enroll in the second year of that language during the freshman year at RHS. **If students enroll in the second year of a world language as a freshmen, then the first year of credit awarded at the middle school level counts on the high school G.P.A.**

Students who have not been successful in English/Language Arts classes in 8th grade should refrain from enrolling in World Language classes in 9th grade.

IMPORTANT NOTE

When a student reenrolls in a course that has already been placed on a transcript, the second time through the course is the grade that counts on the GPA. Exceptions to this are courses that can continue to receive credits multiple times (i.e. band, some PE classes, etc.)
